In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of section 2 of the Central Excise Act, 1944 read with sub-rule (1) of rule 3 of the Central Excise Rules, 2002, the Central Board of Excise and Customs makes the following further amendment in the notification of the Government of India, Ministry of Finance, (Department of Revenue), No.38/2001-Central Excise (N.T.) dated the 26th June, 2001 published in the Gazette of India vide number GSR 467(E), dated the 26th June, 2001 namely: -

(1) In the said notification, in the TABLE, for SI.No.2 and the entries relating thereto, the following shall be substituted, namely: -

1. (1) These rules may be called the CENVAT Credit (Third Amendment) Rules, 2006.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the CENVAT Credit Rules, 2004, in rule 2, in clause (p), the 'Explanation' shall be omitted.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 of the Central Excise Act, 1944 (1 of 1944) and section 94 of the Finance Act, 1994 (32 of 1994), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the CENVAT Credit Rules, 2004, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the CENVAT Credit (Fourth Amendment) Rules, 2006.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the CENVAT Credit Rules, 2004, in rule 6, in sub-rule (6), in clause (vii), for the words and figures "notification No. 6/2002-Central Excise dated the 1st March, 2002", the words and figures "notification No. 6/2002-Central Excise dated the 1st March, 2002 or notification No. 6/2006-Central Excise dated the 1st March, 2006, as the case may be" shall be substituted.

1. (1) These rules may be called the CENVAT Credit (Fifth Amendment) Rules, 2006.

(2) They shall come into force on the 1st day of May, 2006.

2. In the CENVAT Credit Rules, 2004, in rule 9, in sub-rule (1), in clause (e), for the words, brackets and figures “sub-clauses (iii), (iv) and (v)”, the words, brackets and figures “sub-clauses (iii), (iv), (v) and (vii)” shall be substituted.
